

Recovery scenarios




High ٠

 - no resurgence, medium economic recovery, medium-term mode shift ٠
- Low ٠
 - resurgence, slow economic recovery, long-term mode shift away from PT ۲












Bus boardings per day




7-day moving avg, 2020 vs 2019






Mode differences

Revenue shortfall

- 90% of total funding impact

Cost increases

- 10% of total funding impact

Total funding gap in first year

- High recovery: \$100 million
- Central recovery: \$150 million
- Low recovery: \$300 million
